Pre-Treatment Instructions

PROFRACTIONAL, MICROLASER PEEL, BBL BROADBAND LIGHT AND HALO PROCEDURES

IMPORTANT: You must have been off Accutane for one year prior to any laser procedures.

One week prior to procedure until one week following procedure:

- Have **Ibuprofen** on hand to use for pain and fever
- Avoid exposure to sun or tanning beds 4 weeks before & after treatment.
- Absolutely **NO SELF TANNER** (spray tan, topical, lotions, etc.)

Two days before procedure:

Begin taking anti-viral medication as prescribed (Valtrex or Zovirax).

Day of procedure:

- Wash face with a mild soap or cleanser. Do not apply anything to your face after washing. DO NOT COME TO YOUR APPOINTMENT WITH MAKE-UP ON YOUR FACE.
- Take pre-op medication (Valtrex or Zovirax)
- Wear loose, comfortable, **BUTTON-DOWN-THE-FRONT** clothing, warm up suit suggested. Bring scarf and sunglasses to wear when leaving the office, IF DESIRED.
- Optional Bring with you a headband, hair clip or something to hold your hair back off of your face.
 We will provide headband.
- You will be sitting with numbing cream on for about one hour prior to your procedure. Bringing earbuds and/or reading material is encouraged.
- You will be required to read over and sign a Consent Form for Laser Procedures to the Skin. If you have any questions after reading over the consent, please ask.
- Post -operative instructions will be given to you the day of the procedure.
- ProNox which is a patient controlled nitrous gas will be available at additional cost to help assist you
 feel more comfortable during your procedure.

AVOID EXPOSURE TO DIRECT SUNLIGHT FOR AT LEAST 7 DAYS FOLLOWING YOUR PROCEDURE.

The day of your procedure, you will be given a post procedure kit that includes a facial cleanser, and a post-operative ointment.
